

OCHBERG FELLOWSHIPS

DEADLINE: JULY 24, 2009

Reporting responsibly and credibly on violence and traumatic events – on crime, family violence, natural disasters and accidents, war and genocide – are among the greatest challenges facing contemporary journalism. The Dart Center Ochberg Fellowships have been established by the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies and the Dart Center in order to build a cohort of journalists better prepared for this challenge.

Each year, the Dart Center provides six or more expense-paid fellowships to mid-career journalists who want to apply knowledge of emotional trauma to improving the coverage of violent events.

Fellowships are open to print and broadcast reporters, photographers, editors and producers with at least five years of journalism experience.

Fellows will attend a two-day seminar on the role emotional trauma plays in coverage of violent events, then will have access to all events and speakers in the annual conference of the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies (istss.org).

The 2009 seminar will be held November 3-7 in Atlanta, GA.
